




Support working farms and forest, both traditional and nontraditional

- Do not plan to extend utilities, develop major infrastructure, or expand roads in the Comprehensive Plan.
- ➤ Discourage rezoning agricultural land.
- Discourage uses not compatible in scale and character with agriculture.
- Support Agricultural and Forestal Districts and encourage more landowners to participate.

- Recognize the value of quality natural resources for economic development and tourism (esp. Western Slope).
- Incorporate natural resource protection in recreation projects.
- Support naturally dark skies as a goal in the Comprehensive Plan.

Protect Natural Environment and Views

- Update outdoor lighting provisions in the zoning ordinance.
- Allow small scale solar. Discourage siting of utility scale solar.
- Consider applying for Virginia Byway status for routes such as Indian Trail Road.

- ➤ Invite property owners to rezone to Rural Village Zoning District to keep the same feel in the village.



Address Transportation Needs and Opportunities

- As transportation projects are developed the community preferences include:
 - Minimize road widening to those places specifically needed.
 - Consider safety of cyclists.
 - Consider needs of agricultural equipment.
 - Reduce speeds especially in and near the village.

Address Transportation Needs and Opportunities

- Include Keezletown recommendations in the long-range transportation plan and comprehensive plan (ex: no Loop Road or major expansions).
- Strive to enable walkability in the village including the feasibility of a walking path from the Rockingham County Park to Redeemer School.
- Support traffic calming in the village that doesn't interfere with movement of ag equipment





- Host farm-owner workshops on conservation opportunities.
- ➤ Host a workshop for non-farming landowners on programs for clean water, erosion control and habitat enhancement.
- Research and disseminate information on dark sky lighting options.

Property owners request an individual or community-wide rezoning to Rural Village Zoning.




Address Transportation Needs and Opportunities




